This year, I have the honor of presenting two individuals who have achieved this. These men have taken the lessons learned from AIK and myself and have established their own "households", while maintaining a strong bond with the parental "household" (AIK and me). They have exemplified the principles of innovation and refinement that have guided AIK for years.

Jeremy Rose

Jeremy Rose kicked off his martial arts journey at five under Mr. Pilch's guidance, showing early on a vibrant personality and depth. As his skills grew, he stood out as a top student, becoming a junior leader to help with classes and later a key teacher handling daily operations and paperwork for the school. After high school, he expanded to teaching Kenpo Karate at Tucson charter schools.

By nineteen, his talent caught BASIS of Tucson's eye, leading to a full-time PE job blending karate with hundreds of weekly students. He now mentors kids and adults in boxing, kickboxing, MMA, and with Mr. Kalos, oversees AIK's safe, effective program for aspiring competitors.

Josh Kalos

Josh Kalos began martial arts training at age six with AKKA, an affiliate of Mr. Pilch's school, quickly mastering Kenpo's core principles. In his teens, his exceptional talent led him to become the primary instructor for both children and adults. During his late teens and twenties, Mr. Pilch personally mentored him in martial arts and full-contact combat, becoming his main instructor.
